Dear Mother & Dad, New Guinea 6-19-44
 Well June twenty ninth is coming around awful fast and it seems funny to be speaking it in New Guinea. There one thing I like about being here and that is that time passes very fast. Seventeen days at sea sure did pass slow for me. But by some miracle I was not sea sick at all. Quite a few boys were so sick they reminded me of the time Dad told about the fellow on the deep sea fishing trip only we did not have lemons.

We are, and will be on a detail for some time and we are right on the beach and we have lots of time on the beach every day. That's one of the few good breaks I have had, and even though it's winter here, the Carolina sun in August never squalled it here. The greetings are still pouring in and I recieved your letter of June sixth last night. Not so bad and one letter made it in eight days. Love to Dad.
